SUMMER CAMP and THEATER ARTS CAMP 2009
Parent Agreements**

Please read these agreements carefully and sign at the bottom of the page.

FEES AND TUITION:

1. All families must pay \$335 per child at the time of registration.
2. Total Summer Camp and Theater Arts Camp tuition is payable by check or money order to UMHS CCC, due in full by May 31, 2009. If your account is not paid in full by May 31, you may forfeit your spot unless you speak with the director.
3. Tuition cannot be paid through payroll deduction.
4. There is a \$50 drop or change fee for each week dropped or changed after submitting the registration form. This non-refundable fee (not applied toward tuition) will be charged for EACH drop/change made.
5. Weeks may be dropped or changed up until June 15, 2009. **Families will not be refunded any money for weeks dropped once camp begins.**
6. If there is availability, you may add sessions at any time without charge.
7. There is an additional fee of \$25/child for week six of Summer Camp to cover transportation and entrance costs for a long distance field trip.
8. **SUMMER CAMP:** If you need extended care for your child (7:00 – 7:30 a.m. or 5:30 – 6:00 p.m.) you need to sign up for Extended Care at registration. If you do not register for these options, there will be a \$20 charge for each child, each time you are early or late. After 6:00 p.m. the charge is \$2 per minute, per child.
9. **THEATER ARTS CAMP:** No extended care is offered for Theater Arts Camp. If you have your child early or late at Theater Camp, the charge is \$2 per minute before 8:30 a.m. or after 5:30 p.m.

PAYMENTS AND COLLECTIONS POLICY:

The Center is a stand-alone non-profit organization. Its ability to provide services is dependent entirely on its ability to collect sufficient revenues from the fees for monthly tuition to remain financially viable. By signing this agreement, you agree to pay the tuition in advance for the care and education of your child. Exceptions from this policy may only be granted upon written application. Families with remaining balances will be unable to register for camp the following year until the balance is paid. A copy of DSS Licensing Rules is available on the parent information board or upon request.

**FOR THEATER ARTS CAMP ONLY!!! Please read these agreements
carefully and sign at the bottom of the page.**

- **LATE POLICY:** Theater Arts Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 5:30 p.m. There will be **NO STAFF** available before or after camp. \$2/minute will be charged after 5:30 p.m.
- **DAILY ATTENDANCE:** During this four week camp, the campers work **VERY** hard. It is important for the campers to be present each day, for as much of the day as possible. If your camper will miss any days of camp, please let a counselor know at the beginning of camp using the available vacation calendar.
- **AUDITIONS:** Each camper will sing part of a song, learn a dance, and read lines from the script. The counselors will assign character roles based on all three parts of the audition and character choices from each camper.
- **PERFORMANCES:** The campers will have three main performance opportunities in the last few days of camp. The first will be a dress rehearsal; the others will be evening performances.
- **FIELD TRIPS:** The group will go on one field trip each week. The counselors will post what time we will be leaving the day before each trip so families can arrive in time.
- **POOL TRIPS:** In addition to the regular field trips, Theater Arts Camp will go to an Ann Arbor Pool three times a week. Due to inclement weather, pool days may change from what we plan. We therefore ask that campers be prepared to go to the pool each day. The items your camper will need to bring their swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, and pool pass or money for admission each day. Admission is \$3.50 per child; the total for camp will be \$42 or \$10.50 each week. The counselors are willing to hold an envelope containing pool admission money for each week for those who do not want to purchase a pool pass for the entire summer.
- **WATER:** It is imperative that each camper brings a water bottle to camp everyday. As we rehearse lines, songs, and dances, the campers will need to stay hydrated and keep their vocal chords moist. When sending other drinks with your child, please keep in mind that soda pop affects the quality of vocal sound and milk coats the vocal chords and can make it difficult to sing. These items may not ideal to drink during camp hours.
- **SNACKS:** There will be two snacks offered each day of camp. The morning snack will be offered around 9 a.m. and the afternoon snack will be offered around 3:30 p.m. The campers can always access snacks from home or leftover lunch items.

I have read these guidelines and have discussed the importance of following them with my child. I agree to communicate with the counselors about any concerns or changes in a timely fashion. I will help support my child in this new adventure in all ways possible.
