To be used by employees with potential exposure to Ebola from travel to affected areas or patient/specimen/waste exposure.

- All employees providing direct patient care (including lab personnel and anyone managing the waste stream) to patients with suspected or proven Ebola are **REQUIRED** to complete this symptom and temperature monitoring form every day, including days not at work, from the first day of exposure until 21 days after last exposure. For travelers, the monitoring would end 21 days after leaving a country with Ebola epidemic as identified by CDC.
- Employees are **REQUIRED** to monitor temperature twice daily (about every 12 hours) and immediately call OHS (764-8021) for temperature more than or equal to 38.0 degrees C/100.4 degrees F.
- Employees are required to monitor themselves for symptoms below and **must call** OHS before leaving the worksite or coming to work if any of these symptoms develop.
- OHS will be checking daily for monitoring reports from employees who are required to monitor and will contact employees who have not responded daily. If temperature or symptoms develop when OHS is closed, page Infection Prevention at pager # 30032 immediately for further guidance.
- One temperature should be done by direct monitoring; if working on Ebola unit, when checking into work; if working but not on that unit, site manager should be contacted for direct monitoring. Second recording of day may be self reported but indicate both on form.
